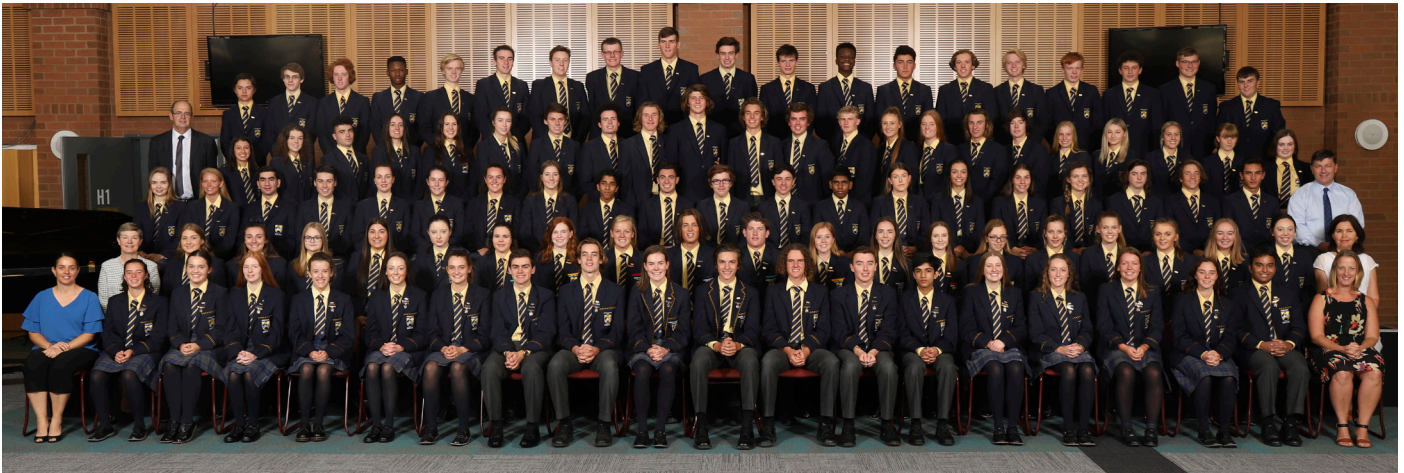




# Congratulations to the VCE Class of 2018

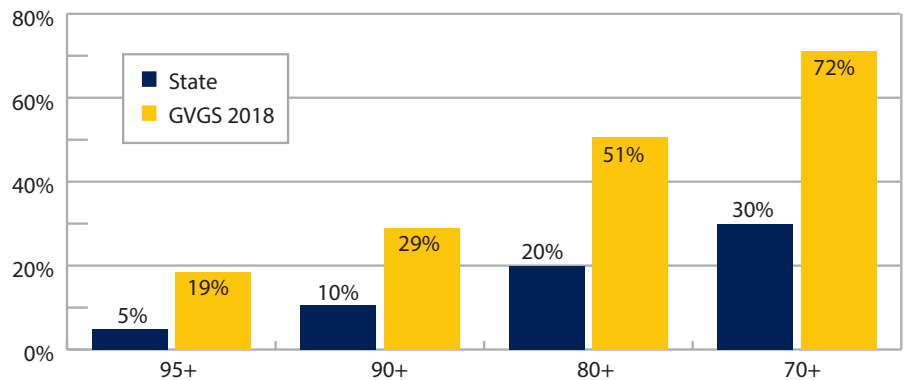
